WINES BY THE GLASS

White Wine

Alvarinho, Aveleda, Vinho Verde, Portugal	175ml £5.50	250ml £7.50
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Intense, harmonious wine with a velvety structure and long, fruity after-taste with notes of passion fruit, white flowers and citrus

Red Wine

Montaria Reserva, Alentejo, Portugal	175ml £5.50	250ml £7.50
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Silky smooth red with deep ruby colour, berries with layers of dark chocolate and eucalyptus – full bodied, smooth and seductive!

CHAMPAGNE & PROSECCO

Prosecco DOC, La Gioiosa, Veneto, Italy	NV	£26.00
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A Prosecco with a fresh bouquet of white flowers, pear and stone fruits.

Bouvet, Saumur Brut, Loire, France	NV	£32.00
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Crafted from Chenin Blanc grapes, using the same 'traditional method' as Champagne, this enhances the honeysuckle-and-citrus-filled body of the wine. A great value alternative to Champagne!

Bouvet Saphir, Saumur Brut, Loire, France	2018	£38.00
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Crémant de Loire is usually just Chenin Blanc. But this vintage version includes a portion of Chardonnay which gives it more of that biscuity brioche character. They even age it for eighteen months which dials up those savoury, bready flavours. Peachy, honeyed and nutty, this is really classy fizz – and an absolute steal for the quality.

Champagne Brut, Louis Roederer, Champagne, France	NV	£75.00
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From the maker of Cristal, a deliciously rich Champagne, with an overt fruitiness and nutty, yeasty notes. A long, complex and rewarding finish is a hallmark of the house style.

ROSE WINE

Monferrato Chiaretto Rosato, Piedmont, Italy	2018	£24.00
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Aromas of fresh strawberry and redcurrants. The ripe and juicy plum and cherry characters on the palate give excellent substance and weight, all balanced by crisp acidity.

LB7 Rose, Lisboa, Portugal	2019	£24.00
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A fresh, dry rosé that's brimming with bright raspberry, strawberry and peach flavours.

WHITE WINE

Italy

Pinot Grigio, Le Colline Di San Giorgio, Veneto, Italy 2019 £24.00

One of Italy's most famous varietal wines characterized by an intense floral bouquet with slightly aromatic highlights and a fresh, balanced taste.

Fiano, Surani Pietrariccia, Campania, Italy 2019 £24.00

Floral, fruity and nutty with a gentle kiss of minerality – a honeyed, complex wine

Grecanico, Terre Siciliane, Sicily 2020 £24.00

Grecanico combines crisp and zesty flavours with full fruitiness – full of juicy ripe peaches, delicious apples and just a smidge of pineapple.

Pecorino, Terre di Chieti, Abruzzo, Italy 2019 £26.00

Fairly simple, but delicious Italian wine with subtle aromas offering lemon, honeysuckle and a hint of tropical fruit. Vibrant acidity brings a crispness on the palate, which delivers granny smith apple, lemon and papaya flavours.

France

Viognier, Mont Rocher, Pays d'Oc, France 2019 £24.00

Haunting honeysuckle and apricot aroma and rich palate that is still dry, tangy and refreshing - an aromatic, fruit driven but fresh Viognier

Touraine, Nicolas Rouzet, Loire, France 2017 £26.00

Crisp flavours of lime, gooseberry and green apples – classic French Sauvignon Blanc

Pouilly Fume, Domaine Pierre Brevin, Loire, France 2017 £36.00

Crisp, gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf fruit aroma overlaid with hints of mineral and citrus with a long, elegant finish with hints of flint and ripe apple

Viognier, Domaine St Ferreol Grande Reserve, Langue d'Oc, France 2016 £38.00

This is a seriously lush, hedonistic wine with natural Viognier flavours of dried apricots and honey bolstered by lees aging. They leave the wine to age for two years in bottle adding a richness, a creaminess of texture which is unbelievably moreish.

Pouilly Fuisse, Domaine Cordier, Burgundy, France 2018 £48.00

Ripe tropical peach and rich toasty oak – full-style Pouilly Fuisse with long harmonious finish

Montagny 1er Cru, Domaine Berthenet 'Les Bonneveaux', France 2016 £52.00

From Guide Hachette's Winemaker of the Year 2020 - needless to say, you can expect big things from this wine. It has complex and rich flavours of ripe fruits, pear, peach and hazelnuts.

Portugal

Alvarinho, Aveleda, Vinho Verde, Portugal 2019 £22.00

Intense, harmonious wine with a velvety structure and long, fruity after-taste with notes of passion fruit, white flowers and citrus

Chamine, Cortes de Cima, Alentejo, Portugal 2018 £24.00

Refreshing Sauvignon Blanc blend with floral and citrus notes and a fresh, fruity finish

Papa Figos, Casa Ferreirinha, Douro, Portugal 2018 £26.00

Intense aroma of tropical fruits with mineral notes with good volume, lively acidity and long finish

Spain

Verdejo, Dominio de la Fuente 2018 £24.00

Crisp flavours of lime, gooseberry and green apples – with a hint of tropical

Germany

Pinot Blanc, Villa Wolf, Pfalz, Germany 2018 £28.00

Elegant, medium-bodied, easy drinking wine with crisp with floral notes and textured stone fruit flavours

South Africa

Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2019 £26.00

Fresh tropical fruits on the nose with mouth-watering, zesty citrus and gooseberry flavours are rounded off by a smoky gunflint finish.

Chenin Blanc, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2019 £26.00

Aromas of apples, pears and a light floral touch with a palate brimming with honeyed tropical fruit

Chardonnay, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2018 £28.00

Complex aromas of citrus and butterscotch, full bodied with layers of ripe apple, roasted almonds and toasty French oak and long, dry finish

New Zealand

Sauvignon Blanc, Devil's Creek Gold Reserve, Marlborough, New Zealand 2018 £28.00

Quintessential New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc – hints of guava and elderflower nose and gooseberry, citrus and ripe melon on the palate

Riesling, Main Divide, Canterbury, New Zealand 2016 £32.00

A slightly off-dry in style. It has notes of honeysuckle, ripe apricot and lime, with a mineral undercurrent and zippy acidity

RED WINE

Italy

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Abruzzo, Italy 2017 £24.00

Full-bodied and brimming with jammy fruit with hints of smoke and spice.

Primitivo, Oltre Passo, Salento, Italy 2018 £24.00

Velvety smooth and wonderfully dense this rich Italian classic has a nose of roasted plum spice and figs, silky-soft and decadent with warm toasty notes

Nero di Troia, Terre Avare, Puglia, Italy 2017 £26.00

Blackberries and ripe cherries on the nose with fresh notes of red fruit – elegant and harmonious

Salice Salentino Riserva, Puglia, Italy 2018 £26.00

Like Montepulciano on steroids - just bursting with juicy red fruits with just a dash of sophisticated spice. Perfect with food or without. Crack this open and put your feet up - you deserve it!

Barbera d'Alba, Villa de Forville, Piedmont, Italy 2018 £28.00

Using fruit from 40 year old vines. Very concentrated dark fruits on the nose, with well-integrated spices. Dark cherry fruit flavours with hints of chocolate, cloves and vanilla.

Appassimento, Puglia, Italy 2019 £28.00

Rich, smooth and satisfyingly powerful, every drop of this dark, brooding wine is jam-packed with tantalisingly intense fruit, all wrapped in a big oaky hug.

Barbaresco, de Forville, Piedmont, Italy 2016 £36.00

A big, elegant wine, dark cherries and leather with earthy hints – well integrated wine with a long finish.

Le Volte Dell' Ornellaia, Tuscany, Italy 2017 £48.00

Bordeaux-inspired, early-drinking 'super-Tuscan' blend, marrying Bordeaux varieties with the local Sangiovese - a sense of opulence.

Brunello DOCG, Agostini Pieri di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy 2015 £58.00

This is one of Italy's finest red wines. Made by a small family winery that consistently provides great value in an otherwise expensive region. It's full-bodied and silky, with flavours of red and black fruits, basil and mint.

France

Carignan, Baron de Baussac, Languedoc, France 2018 £24.00

A really tasty single variety wine – characteristically colourful and spicy

Chateau Vessiere, Costieres de Nimes, Rhone, France 2016 £28.00

Delicate nose of rose petals and pomegranate seeds with complex palate of sweet cherries and blueberries

Chateau Parenchere, Bordeaux Superior, Bordeaux, France 2015 £30.00

Elegant with flavours of plum and cassis and a good balance of fruit and tannins

Portugal

Montaria Reserva, Alentejo, Portugal 2016 £22.00

Silky smooth red with deep ruby colour, berries with layers of dark chocolate and eucalyptus – full bodied, smooth and seductive!

Ciconia, Touriga Nacional, Alentejo, Portugal 2018 £22.00

Deep ruby hue with violet hints, aroma of wood fruits, white flowers and truffles with chocolate and vanilla notes. Round, rich taste of fruits and spices.

Chamine, Cortes de Cima, Alentejo, Portugal 2017 £24.00

Soft, rich berry fruit – deliciously juicy!

Papa Figos, Casa Ferreirinha, Douro, Portugal 2018 £26.00

Deep ruby hue with intense bouquet of red fruits and a hint of spice with an elegant body and well-balanced red fruit palate and extended finish

Prazo de Roriz, Douro, Portugal 2016 £30.00

Deep garnet colour. Red fruit, raspberry and cherry with mineral touch and appealing spicy notes.

Monte Cascas, Alentejo, Portugal 2014 £30.00

Deep purply red colour, nose of red fruit, coffee and chocolate. Fresh red fruit on palate with steady, persistent earthy character.

Spain

Rioja Crianza, Cune, Rioja, Spain 2015 £24.00

Soft aromas of toasted oak and vanilla, good balance between fruit and spice in a long, elegant finish

Pinot Noir, Clos Mont Blanc, Catalonia, Spain 2016 £34.00

Bright, lively wine with sweet cherry notes, vanilla and subtle spice with delicious flavours of plum jam and subtle vanilla – moreish!

Argentina

Malbec, Verne, Mendoza, Argentina 2017 £28.00

Deeply coloured, powerful red with a great concentration of berry fruit with flavours of plums, figs and dried fruit and a hint of smoky vanilla

Chile

Merlot, Quincho, Central Valley, Chile 2019 £24.00

Berry and ripe fruit with notes of vanilla and butterscotch – smooth and velvety with great texture

Carmenere, Odfjell Orzada, Central Valley, Chile 2018 £36.00

Complex nose with spices, ripe red fruits, blackberries and tobacco, concentrated and juicy palate with a velvety, soft finish

Carignan, Odfjell Orzada, Maule Valley, Chile 2018 £38.00

Complex aromas of blueberries, cherries, strawberries, plums and tobacco, refreshing palate with round tannins and notes of dried plums and chocolate

South Africa

Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2018 £26.00

Aromas of ripe black raspberry and a touch of spice. Smooth and well balanced on the palate with succulent spiced berry fruit, and toasted mocha. Soft tannins and subtle oakiness ensures a fun filled easy drinking fruity style.

Pinotage, Simonsig, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2016 £28.00

Intensely aromatic with notes of sweet raspberry, flavours of plum and concentrated berry fruit

Pinot Noir, Creation, Walker Bay, South Africa 2019 £38.00

A bright, polished wine with notes of red berries, vanilla and wood spice

Australia

Pinot Noir, Stonier, Mornington Peninsula, Australia 2017 £38.00

Mornington Peninsula has long been Australia's best spot for top-shelf Pinot Noir. Taste the cool-climate excellence in structured notes of red fruits and spice and a luscious finish.
